POLICY STATEMENT 6.0: REGISTRATION OF MEMBERS

- 6.1 The governing authority for provisions regarding membership is Athletics New Brunswick (ANB) By-law I - 0 - 0.
- 6.2 Notwithstanding the above, and as per Policy Statement 7.0(C), Athletics Canada membership rules take precedence over any Branch policies or rules.
- 6.3 Membership in ANB shall be open to any individual who has been in a resident of the province for at least 90 days. Additionally, membership shall be open to any athlete attending a training centre out of province and any full or part time student resident in New Brunswick but attending school elsewhere.
- 6.4 Notwithstanding By-law I - 0 - 0, the membership categories recognized by ANB shall be (age determined as of 31 December):
- A) COMPETITIVE:
 - a) Masters (as defined by Athletics Canada)
 - b) Senior (age 20 and over)
 - c) Junior (age 18 and 19)
 - d) Juvenile (age 16 and 17)
 - e) Midget (age 14 and 15)
 - f) Bantam (age 12 and 13)
 - g) Peewee (age 11 and under)

 - B) PROGRAM:
 - a) Legion Program athletes
 - b) NBIAA Program athletes
 - c) Road Racers
 - d) Day Members

 - C) NON-COMPETITIVE:
 - a) Officials
 - b) Coaches
 - c) Associates
 - d) Instructors
 - e) Lifetime
- 6.5 Membership registration shall be the responsibility of the ANB Registrar and shall be done on approved forms which shall include a schedule of fees as set by the membership at the AGM. Said forms shall be available to clubs and individuals not later than 15 November following the AGM.
- 6.6 Any individual or club registering after the end of September shall have their membership extended to 31 December of the following year.
- 6.7 An athlete registering with a club may not transfer to another club during the same calendar year unless he/she has completed an Athlete Transfer Form (see PS 6.0 appendix) and paid the athlete transfer fee.
- 6.8 Membership in Athletics New Brunswick for all categories shall include insurance coverage, the cost of which shall be included in the required membership fee. Day Members are covered at the specific event for which the day fee is paid.

6.9 A competitive membership shall be mandatory for any athlete traveling out of province competitions.
