POLICY STATEMENT 9.0: PROVINCIAL TEAM ELIGIBILITY

- 9.1 This selection "system" is designed to be generic in nature so that it might be applicable to ANB sponsored provincial teams.
- 9.2 To be considered for selection to an ANB Provincial Team, an athlete must fulfill the following criteria:
 - a) be a resident of New Brunswick for a period of not less than 90 days prior to the Meet/Games for which selection is desired. Resident is defined as residing full time within the province; or in full time study or full time training with national level coaches outside the province, but having a custodial parent living in New Brunswick; or a full time student from elsewhere studying in New Brunswick.
 - b) be a full "competitive" member of Athletics New Brunswick at least 60 days prior to the Meet/Games for which selection is desired.
 - c) meet the performance standards required by the Meet/Games/Program.
- 9.3 Specific selection requirements for Canada Games and Jeux de la Francophonie teams will be proposed by Games staff and approved by the Board of Directors, including specific age limitations and/or requirements. Other requirements may be established by "outside" sponsoring bodies.
- 9.4 Teams designated Senior are specifically for Senior athletes; Junior for Junior athletes. Notwithstanding this, any athlete fulfilling the criteria as outlined in 9.2 and 9.3 has the right to try for selection and be selected based on superior performance.
- 9.5 Automatic selection to any provincial team is dependent upon meeting the specific criteria as established by team staff and approved by the Board of Directors.
- 9.6 Athletes meeting the general criteria but not quite achieving the performance criteria MAY be considered for a team position that remains open following the selection based on performance.
- 9.7 Where two or more athletes are qualified for selection, the individual with the lower percent differential to the performance standard will be selected.
- 9.8 Qualifying performances, where required, must be made in the age category for which the athlete is applying to compete. This primarily applies to Hurdle and Throwing events.
