ATHLETICS NEW BRUNSWICK

POLICY STATEMENT 4.0: PROVINCIAL RECORDS

- 4.1 The Athletics New Brunswick (ANB) Statistician shall keep separate (native) records for the Indoor and Outdoor seasons for the following age categories:
 - a) Master (35 year and older)
 - b) Senior (20 yrs. and older)
 - c) Junior (18 & 19 yrs.)
 - d) Youth (16 & 17 yrs.)
 - e) Midget (14 & 15 yrs.)
 - f) Bantam (13 yrs and under)
- 4.2 The events for which records shall be kept are listed on the pages of the Athletics NB website used for recording records.
- 4.3 To establish a provincial record an athlete must be a full "competitive" member of ANB prior to the meet in which the record performance is achieved.
- 4.4 Provincial records may only be set at meets sanctioned by the IAAF, Athletics Canada, or their constituent members at a recognized facility and deemed by the ANB Technical Director to have been properly officiated.
- 4.5 Verification of record performance must be received by the statistician in one of the following ways:
 - a) Reference to website containing official meet results.
 - b) Completion of a Provincial Record Application form.(see attached)
 - c) An official copy of meet results.
 - d) A written statement of record performance signed by a qualified event official at the meet or a National Event Coach who does not coach the athlete for whom the record application is submitted.
- 4.6 Wind readings must be recorded for all performances up to and including the 200m as well as the Long Jump and Triple Jump for a record to be recognized by ANB, effective the Outdoor season, 1993.
- 4.7 For records purposes electronic timing is required for all track events up to and including the 400m, effective the Outdoor Season 1995.
- 4.8 In Bantam, Midget, and Youth age categories applications for records in the Shot Put, Discus Throw, Hammer Throw, and Hurdles, set out-of-province, must include the implement weights and heights for the Hurdles.
